Adult Social Care Workforce Data Set (ASC-WDS)



ASC-WDS is a useful workforce tool

- Important that care providers understand the **value** of contributing to ASC-WDS and how it helps the sector
- But it's not just a data collection service...
 - Free and safe place to store staff records and to manage training and quals
 - Benchmark key workforce metrics against similar providers
 - Access to benefits bundle (special offers and discounts)
 - Claim funding for staff training through Workforce Development Fund and the ASC Training and Development Fund.



Claiming funding for training

- [The Workforce Development Fund](#)
 - Eligible qualifications and apprenticeships
 - Started before 31 March 2024 and completed by 31 March 2025
 - Claim from Skills for Care
 - ASC-WDS eligibility checker

Assessments update

- Since the launch of the Single Assessment Framework, **447** ASC assessments have been completed and a further **17** are due to be published imminently.
- A further **653** assessments are in progress.
- The most common quality statements reviewed are ‘**safe and effective staffing**’, ‘**involving people to manage risks**’, and ‘**safeguarding**’.
- An average of **10.2** quality statements are reviewed per assessment.
